**The recent data breach at Equifax has exposed Social Security numbers and other sensitive personal information of millions of people.** We wanted to remind you that Health Advocate experts are here to help.



The data breach at Equifax, the national major credit reporting agency, occurred between mid-May and July.

**To find out if your information has been exposed, follow these steps:**

1. Visit [www.equifaxsecurity2017.com](http://www.equifaxsecurity2017.com)
2. Click on the “Potential Impact” tab and then the “Check Potential Impact” button.
3. Enter your last name and the last six digits of your Social Security number. (Make sure you’re on a secure computer and an encrypted network connection any time you enter your Social Security number.) The site will tell you if you’ve been affected by the breach.
4. While on the site, you have the opportunity to sign up for free credit file monitoring, prevent access to your Equifax credit report by third parties, and other services.
